21. Discussion regarding Pride Month

Mrs. McNaney said Pride Month runs the entire month of June. Many municipalities, schools and businesses will fly the pride flag for the month. Mrs. Damsker said the county flies the flag also and since we just formed the HRC and want to be inclusive, that we should support pride month. Mrs. Simelaro agreed with Mrs. Damsker. Mrs. Carter said this would show our respect for all cultures, people and diversity. Mrs. Hull said June has become the month to recognize our LGBTQ community. On June 26, 2015, the US Supreme Court struck down all state bans on same sex marriages and legalized same sex marriage in all 50 states and required states to honor out of state same sex marriage licenses. She said it is the perfect month to celebrate all of our residents who are LGBTQ and to let them know that Upper Gwynedd is a safe place for them to live, work and play. Mrs. McNaney agreed with the comments.

Richard Buttacavoli, 27 Lincoln Avenue, Lansdale, commended the Commissioners for discussing this subject this evening. He mentioned that many nearby communities will be flying the flag, and this shows that Upper Gwynedd is a welcoming community. It encourages businesses to move into UGT. Mr. Buttacavoli is the founding member of the Montgomery County LGBT business council.

Mrs. Zadell said we will fly the pride flag the whole month of June.
