1. Call to order

The March 30, 2020, Public Meeting of the Upper Gwynedd Township Board of Commissioners was called to order by President of the Board, Liz K. McNaney at 11:02 am.

5. Public comments and concerns (limit of five minutes per individual)

Ginny Yulich, 315 Bradford Lane said she is having difficulty applying for unemployment. Ms. Gallagher said the Board has no control over the unemployment website and to continue to try to get through.

6. Motion to ratify the emergency declaration that was approved on March 17, 2020

Mrs. McNaney read portions of the emergency declarations which authorizes officials of Upper Gwynedd Township to act as necessary to meet the current demands of this emergency.

Mrs. McNaney asked if the declarations have to be updated every seven (7) days or if we can establish a longer time period. Ms. Gallagher is recommending the declarations be updated every seven (7) days.

8A. Motion to ratify the payment of part-time employees through March 27, 2020

8B. Motion to ratify the Township Social Distancing Policy

Hearing no public questions or comments, upon motion by Mrs. Simelaro, seconded by Mrs. Hull, the motion was unanimously approved.

9. <u>Consideration of extending the discount period for municipal taxes.</u>

Mrs. Zadell said the current discount period ends tomorrow and the face period ends in two (2) months. The Board is considering extending the discount period until May 31 and the face period until July 31. The Township tax collector said 85% of the taxes have already paid. Ms. Gallagher said the County has requested the municipalities extend the discount period for two (2) months. She added that it is appropriate and legal. This will get posted on the website, front door and social media if approved. We will also send a letter to the County about the extension. The earned income tax has already been extended by the State.
