## 2013 TOWNSHIP BUDGET

The Upper Gwynedd Township Board of Commissioners is pleased to announce that at their November 20, 2012, Public Workshop Meeting, the 2013 Preliminary Budget was authorized for advertisement. This Budget is based on the same real estate tax level that was in place in 2012 at 1.012 mills of assessed value. At the rate of 1.012 mills, the owner of a home assessed at the Township's average pays \$110 annually. The Township Board of Commissioners reauthorized the Homestead Exemption which further reduces the real estate tax burden on owner occupied residential properties. In addition, the Budget reflects the same sewer rates that were in place in 2012 at a rate of \$322.00 per year.

**In summary, the Budget includes a spending plan that includes revenues and expenditures as follows:**

General Fund ..... \$10,517,659  
Sewer Fund ..... \$3,241,020  
Sewer Revenue Acct. .... \$1,338,768  
Liquid Fuels Fund ..... \$350,000  
Sewer Expansion Fund... \$9,094,700

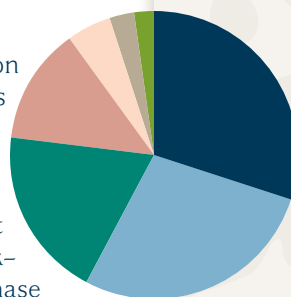
In addition to normal operation and maintenance expenses, this Budget includes the following major capital projects:

**General Fund:** West Point Streetscape Project (\$455k-\$300k from grant), purchase of one Police vehicle (\$38k), Road milling & overlay projects (\$881k-\$350k from State), and Community Center ADA improvements (\$60k-\$60k from grant).

**Sewer Fund:** The continuation of the Upper Gwynedd Township Inflow/Infiltration Reduction Program and Service Building brick and roof repairs (\$70k).

**Sewer Revenue Acct:** The continuation of the Upper Gwynedd Township Inflow/Infiltration Reduction Program.

**Sewer Expansion Fund:** The Phosphorus Filtration System (\$5,270k-\$5,270k from award) and North Wales Water Authority (North Wales Borough) Sewer Interconnect Project (\$1,982k-\$1,982k from grant).

The Board of Commissioners' President Kenneth E. Kroberger thanked all the Members of the Board, Township Manager Leonard T. Perrone, Township Finance Director David Brill, and all of the Department Heads for their diligence through the Budget preparation process. He indicated that many of the difficult choices were made in a successful effort to develop a Budget which held the line on taxes for the 17th consecutive year without a tax increase. Further, the Township reduced its real estate tax by 33 % in 2001.

# Important Mailbox Placement Announcement

Township work crews have reported that many residents have mailboxes that protrude over the face of the curb and/or over the paved area of Township roads. The Township is taking this opportunity to notify residents that this causes problems during snow removal and/or road resurfacing efforts undertaken by the Township.

Mailboxes must be installed or reinstalled so that they are even with the back (behind the curb to the property side) of the curb line and/or beyond the edge of the black top where curbs do not exist.

During the winter months when snow

plowing operations are taking place, the opportunity that your mailbox could be hit by a plow will be minimized by complying with these regulations.

Also in the summer months when paving operations take place, the paving equipment must be even with the curb. By having your mailbox meet these requirements, once again, the chance of your mailbox being hit will be minimal.

Please be advised that should your mailbox not meet the above requirements and damage is done by a Township vehicle or contractor, you will not be compensated nor will your mailbox be replaced. ❄️



## REMEMBER:

**Mailboxes should be installed so the front is even with the back of the curb.**

**If no curb, the face should be 6 inches from the road.**

## PA DEP Mandate

Upper Gwynedd Township is currently under a mandate from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (PA DEP) to remove infiltration and inflow from its Sanitary Sewer System. Infiltration is ground water that enters the sewer system through damaged mains and sewer laterals coming from homes and businesses. Inflow comes from sources such as downspouts and sump pumps.

The Township along with residents are currently undertaking a repair and replacement program for sewer laterals that will eventually encompass all residential and business contributors throughout the Township. The Township will continue televising work in Gwynedeer and other neighboring developments during the next few months. Upon review of the data, residents will be notified when a problem is found and given one year to make the repair/replacement. If your lateral has cracks, loose pipe joints, or tree roots, you must have it repaired or replaced.

When rainwater is allowed into the sewer laterals, the sewer mains can overload. Sewage Treatment Plants are designed to treat the wastewater from homes, businesses and industries throughout the community. But when connected downspouts, sump pumps and leaky laterals let rainwater into the system, the extra water can overload the sewage treatment facility. ❧



## Leonard T. Perrone Received ICMA Award for 35 Years of Service

Leonard T. Perrone was honored for the achievement of serving 35 years in local government by the International City/County Management Association at their annual conference in Phoenix, Arizona in October 2012.

Len received his inspiration towards a career in public service through his father who was very active as a volunteer in summer baseball programs in the Borough of Norristown. Following Len's graduation from the University of South Carolina with a degree in Government and Public Administration in 1975, Len pursued a Post-Graduate degree at The American University in Washington D.C. Len received his Masters in Public Administration (MPA) in December of 1976.

Len received his first position in public management when he became the Assistant Borough Manager in Lansdale in the spring of 1977. In 1979, he was appointed to the position of Manager of the Borough of Hatfield. In assuming this position, he became Hatfield Borough's first Manager. During his ten-year



career in Hatfield, Len was responsible for having acquired many community development grants, reconstructed and managed the Borough's electric system, and improved the Borough's water and sewer systems.

In the fall of 1989, Len was chosen by the Board of Commissioner's to be Upper Gwynedd's Township Manager. While serving Upper Gwynedd Township, Len has helped to guide the Township through many projects and has advanced the services that affect the quality of life for the Township residents.

Included in these projects is the completion of many highway and bridge improvements and the incorporation of the former Upper Gwynedd Sewer Authority into a department of the Township. Following this incorporation the Township has expanded and improved these facilities making it a state-of-the-art facility. The development of the Township's Parks and Recreation facilities and programs are amongst Len's more prideful accomplishments. All of the above have been done while managing the Township in a fiscally efficient and responsible manner. ❧

## If a Downspout or Sump Pump is Connected to Your Lateral, You Must Have it Disconnected!

In association with the PA DEP Mandate and the Township's on-going effort to reduce inflow and infiltration in the collection system, a Home Inspection Program has been put into place. Residents will receive a letter from the Township to schedule a convenient time to have a Wastewater Treatment Plant representative inspect their sump pump and roof drains to verify that they are not connected to the Sanitary Sewer System. This inspection is free of charge and will benefit all Township residents in the future. The Township thanks everyone for their cooperation in making this a successful endeavor.
