UPPER GWYNEDD TOWNSHIP 2016 BUDGET APPROVAL

he Upper Gwynedd Township Board of Commissioners is pleased to announce that at their November 23, 2015, Public Workshop Meeting, the 2016 Preliminary Budget was authorized for advertisement. This Budget is based on the same real estate tax level that was in place in 2015 at 2.012 mills of assessed value. At the rate of 2.012 mills, the owner of a home assessed at the township's average pays \$220 annually. The Township Board of Commissioners reauthorized the Homestead Exemption which further reduces the real estate tax burden on owner occupied residential properties. In addition, the Budget reflects the same sewer rates that were in place in 2015. It is very important for taxpayers to understand that the Township does not control the tax levy imposed by either the North Penn School District or the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners. In 2015, the Township real estate tax represented only 7% of your total annual real estate tax bill while the School District's tax represented 82 % and the County tax represented 11 %.

In summary, the Budget includes a spending plan that includes revenues and expenditures as follows:

In addition to normal operation and maintenance expenses, this Budget includes the following major capital projects:

General Fund:

Public Meeting Room technology upgrades (\$35k), purchase of one Police patrol vehicle (\$32k), construction of a carport and stair-cover for Police Station (\$167k), road milling & overlay projects (\$926k–\$770k from State), stormwater management projects (\$782k–\$400k from Grants), replacement of a Public Works 1999 dump truck and a 1995 pick-up truck (\$189k), and park improvements including installation of two dedicated pickleball courts (\$127k).

Sewer Fund: The

continuation of

the Upper Gwynedd Township Inflow/ Infiltration Reduction Program (\$395k), and construction of a storage garage for mobile equipment (\$106k).

Upper Collection System Fund: The continuation of the Upper Gwynedd Township Inflow/Infiltration Reduction Program (\$260k) and design engineering of diversion project (\$535k).

The Board of Commissioners' President Kenneth E. Kroberger thanked all the Members of the Board, Township Manager Leonard T. Perrone, Township Finance Director David Brill, Assistant Township Manager Michael Lapinski, and all of the Department Heads for their diligence through the Budget preparation process. Mr. Kroberger indicated that many difficult choices were made in a successful effort to develop a Budget which held the line on taxes and sewer rates without reducing the level of services provided by the Township.

Pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance 61-2, as amended, of the Township, during periods of emergency snow conditions, no person shall park a vehicle or permit a vehicle to stand unattended upon any portion of any of the roads within the Township. This is to assist snow plow operators in clearing the streets. A snow emergency shall be declared by the Township Manager posted on the Township website at www.uppergwynedd. org. and announced over radio stations WNPV 1440 and KYW 1060. As a courtesy to the Township's snow plow operators and your neighbors, the Township requests that residents remove portable basketball stands from the street area and refrain from putting out trash and recycling containers that also hinder snow removal efforts.
