### A.

# **B.** Smoking in Parks

Mr. Kaker led a discussion about smoking in the parks and whether or not the township should enforce a no smoking/tobacco ban within the parks. Mrs. Edelmayer called it a no-brainer. The State of Pennsylvania's Health Department has a program that sponsors signs for townships to place within parks at no cost to the township. A motion was made by Mr. Murray that the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board highly recommends to the Board of Commissioners that the township should adopt an ordinance that prohibits tobacco, tobacco products and e-cigarettes to be banned from Township parks and open spaces. It was seconded by Mr. Zumpiono and the motion passed unanimously.
