Ordinance. This motion was seconded by Mr. Tierney and the motion to recommend approval of the Proposed Zoning Amendment was unanimously passed.

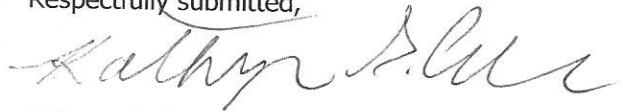
Public Comments/Questions:
