An event is ONLY approved after final approval is granted by both the Upper Gwynedd Police and the Upper Gwynedd Board of Commissioners. This signed application along with a proposed route and a detailed event plan is to be submitted to the Upper Gwynedd Police Department for review. You will be contacted by them to coordinate the event further.

Race directors must agree to the following:

- 1. Submit a detailed event plan with initial application
- 2. Submit map(s) of all affected areas/routes (Google Earth or Similar) with initial application
- 3. Race director must remain on location during the event.
- 4. Agree to notify, <u>in writing</u>, residents along the route of any event using roadways within Upper Gwynedd

- 5. All volunteers working in a traffic control duty are required to wear fluorescent/reflective traffic vests.
- 6. Upper Gwynedd Township has limited resources, equipment and manpower. In some cases we may be able to provide the required cones, barricades, traffic vests etc. however this may not be an option in all cases. In those cases it will be the race director's responsibility to obtain the required safety equipment as determined and established by the Upper Gwynedd Police/Township.
- 7. If your event requires additional manpower than that which is already scheduled to work, the race director will be responsible and billed accordingly. This will be specifically discussed with the race director if needed.
- 8. It will be the responsibility of the race director to put out cones and barricades on the course. The police department may be able to assist however it remains the director's responsibility. An officer will review the course prior to the start of the race to ensure it is set up consistent with the plans.
- 9. It is the race director's responsibility to remove all trash, debris, signs etc. from the race area immediately following the event.
- 10. No permanent markings are permitted to be used on the course.
- 11. The group/organization agrees to add the Township as an additional insured to any general liability insurance policy maintained by the group/organization. Such coverage is to be primary and non-contributory. A waiver of subrogation in favor of the Township on the comprehensive liability and workers compensation coverages is to be included. A certificate of insurance is to be provided to the Township giving evidence of such coverage prior to the use of the Township facilities. A copy of the workers compensation endorsement providing waiver of subrogation on the Township's behalf is to be sent to the Township upon availability and prior to the use of the Township facilities.
