 - **ZHB 20-07** WB Homes use variance request to develop Jeppy Property, Sumneytown Pike. Applicant originally presented 24 apartment units, but it was amended to 17 townhouses. It has been continued indefinitely but a March 23, 2021 date is likely.
 - **ZHB 21-01** 920 S. Broad St. Variance to permit (2) apartments on 2nd floor in R-2 District where previously this was approved for office use by ZHB in 1988. Approved by ZHB on January 26, 2021

- **180 Wissahickon Avenue –** Land development for use in the LI (Limited Industrial) District. Scheduled for 2nd review by UGTPC February 10, 2021.
- **814 Ridgeview Drive, Gwynedd Ridge (Pulte Subdivision) –** Applicant requesting approval to install a fence across a 20 ft. wide storm sewer easement. This requires approval of an Encroachment Agreement.
