 - **Summer Weather** as we have noticed recently the summer weather in our area generates intense thunderstorms that can be short duration but a high volume of rainfall. Our storm and stream systems throughout the Township are designed to handle a certain

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intensity of rainfall and when this gets exceeded the water essentially has to wait its turn to get into our pipes and waterways. To make our system work as efficiently as possible, please help keep storm drains clear of debris and avoid placing items in drainage pathways. Always use caution with high waters during storms and usually with short storms the water will be able to subside in a reasonable amount of time.
