The Counselor In Training Program is for teens ages 13 - 15 that are too old for camp and not old enough to be a counselor. This program is geared to develop leadership skills and a basic understanding of camp operations. Although this is an unpaid, volunteer position, CITs are an important part of Camp Parkside. CITs are responsible for aiding the counselors in every facet of camp such as assisting in set-up/clean-up, participating and leading games, helping campers with small tasks and much more. CITs will assist in the appropriate supervision and interaction of campers and help enhance their camp experience.

Camp Parkside is designed to be fun for the children. Children come first. We want the children to be interested and excited about summer camp. Your job this summer is to learn how to be an active leader and participate with all campers in all activities.

WHAT WE ARE LOOKING FOR:

In designing a Counselor In Training program, it is our objective to develop the following characteristics in each trainee:

- A well-rounded, sensitive and mature young person
- An understanding of people, particularly of children and self through:
 - *Training and program experience*
 - *A group experience with peers*
 - *Group discussions and activities with camp staff*
- Respect and acceptance for all people and children, with appreciation of diversity
- The ability to have fun while learning and teaching
