This program is geared to develop leadership skills and a basic understanding of camp operations. Although this is an unpaid, volunteer position, CITs are an important part of Camp Parkside. CITs are responsible for aiding the counselors in every facet of camp such as assisting in set-up/clean-up, participating and leading games, helping campers with small tasks and much more. CITs will assist in the appropriate supervision and interaction of campers and help enhance their camp experience.
