



## Q2 Are you a resident of Upper Gwynedd Township?



### Q3 How many years have you lived in Upper Gwynedd Township?













## Q10 Are you employed within Upper Gwynedd Township?



### Q11 What one method of transportation do you usually use (for the longest portion of your commute) to travel to work?



### Q12 How long is your average commute to work?







### Q15 What Neighborhood Area do you live in?



### Q16 What do you see as priorities for your neighborhood over the next 20 years? Select your top 3 choices.







## Q22 Are you employed within Upper Gwynedd Township?



### Q23 What one method of transportation do you usually use (for the longest portion of your commute) to travel to work?


